 - No Stage Grouping available for post neo-adjuvant T N M

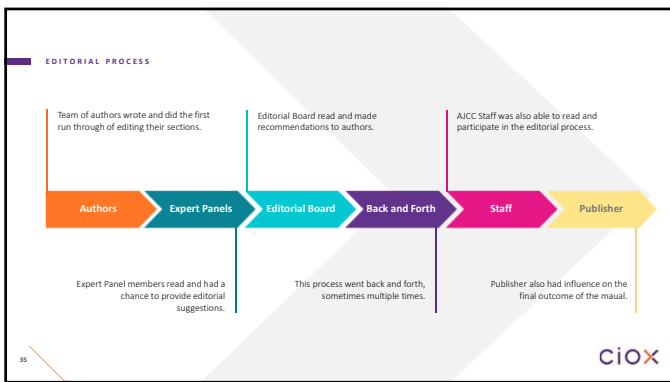
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OVERALL AND UNIVERSAL CHANGES



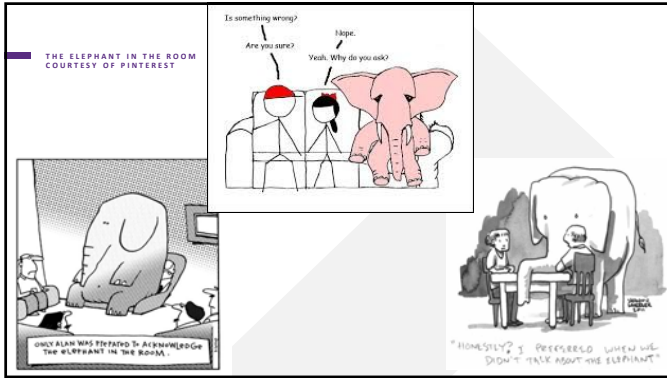
